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ow the exam will proceed:

- . The Chair announces the name of the Candidate and the title of the thesis to be examined and introduces the Candidate and all members of the Examinin Committee.
- 2. The Chair describes how the exam will be conducted as follows:
 - a. The Candidate will be asked to present their research (30-4 minutes for h.D. students). After the presentation, there ma a -minute break.
 - b. The Examinin Committee will then take turns in askin questions, t picall no more than 20-30 minutes per member. Questionin be ins with the External Examiner followed b the Internal (or ublic) Examiner, the upervisor Committee members, and concludes with the enior upervisor.
 - c. The Chair will ask the Examinin Committee if the wish to have a second round of questions. If so, Examiners will ask questions in the same order as for the first round. enerall , this round is limited to onl a few questions from each examiner.
 - d. The Chair will then invite questions from the audience.
 - e. After the question period, the Candidate will be asked to withdraw while the Examinin Committee deliberates.
- 3. The Chair announces that recordin or transmission of an part of the defence is prohibited unless approved b the Chair, the student, and all members of the examinin committee.
- 4. The examination then unfolds as described b the Chair. If a question from the audience seems to be inappropriate or irrelevant, the Chair ma ask the advice of the Examinin Committee as to the suitabilit of the question, allowin the Committee to authorize or refuse public questions.
- . At the end of all questionin , the audience and Candidate are asked to withdraw while the Committee completes its evaluation. The Candidate is asked to wait somewhere nearb .
- 6. The Examinin Committee will be presented with followin options:
 -) The thesis was passed as submitted.
 - 2) The thesis was passed on the condition that minor revisions be completed to the satisfaction of:
 - a. the enior upervisor. All other members of the Examinin Committee si n the Thesis, OR
 - b. the Examinin Committee. ome members have withheld si natures pendin revisions
 - 3) The Examinin Committee deferred makin jud ment. The thesis was considered to be passable after additional work b the candidate.
 - a. A second oral defense will be required, OR
 - b. The Examinin Committee will reach its decision based on the written, revised thesis. A re-defense is not required , c E 3 w) p w 4 - D j p c s s
