By avoiding duplication of conversation at Board meetings, the expectation is that there will be more time for the Board to strategically focus on the most important and pressing issues, to track emerging issues and to manage key risks as they develop. It is also incumbent on the Board to be more accountable in the development of agendas. She noted that this process will continue to evolve as we test and learn, and she encouraged feedback from governors toward ensuring that the structures and processes adopted support the Board in its work.
