

BPK896– PhD Comprehensive Examination Enrolment Form

The Comprehensive examination is a requirement in the PhD program. A research proposal written by the student will be evaluated and scored by the supervisory committee and an examiner who is external to the committee. Once a satisfactory score is reached, the student will present their research proposal for oral examination by the supervisory committee and external examiner. The GPC chair or designate will chair the comprehensive examination proceedings. It is expected that PhD students complete the comprehensive examination within their first 4 semesters. Students who have transferred from the MSc to the PhD program would be expected to complete the comprehensive exam within 3 semesters of their transfer.
