Compassion is not exclusive to any individual group or ideology, and is a fundamental human need across all facets of society. The intended outcome of discussing compassion is not to lobby for additional government money or programs—rather, it is to build social capital among civil society, businesses, and municipal governments, and to strengthen collective resilience for addressing growing social, environmental, and economic development challenges.

• *Promoting volunteerism.* Louisville, Kentucky is implementing a "Mayor's Day of Service" to mobilize volunteer businesses and citizens.

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
