The mace was commissioned by University architects Erickson and Massey, and was presented to the University at the opening ceremonies on September 9, 1965. Pieces of cut and polished jade, which were taken from the University's jade boulder in the AQ Reflection Pond, were set in silver by its designer, Haida artist Bill Reid. The mace is crowned by a silver stag's head, derived from the coat-arms of Lord Lovat, head of the Clan Fraser. The Fraser tradition was to fasten sprigs of yew in the bonnets befo2 (s)7.51.7 (he
