HUBERT EVANS is known to Canadian writers as "the elder of the tribe", a tribute both to the man and to his work, carried out over a great many years, sometimes under conditions of adversity such as his near-blindness. Milton's poem, "On His Rlindness" enote of "that one talant subject in deat . 1.1" Evans, by will and by faith, has not hidden that talent but has continued to develop
