In 1979 and 1981, Downs Archambault completed the Classroom and Museum Block and the Diamond Alumni Centre at SFU and later, in joint venture with other Canadian architects, played distinctive roles in the development of several of Vancouver's current civic icons, including Canada Place, Pan Pacific Hotel and Library Square.

In addition to these accomplishments, through his contributions to a series of award-winning books on topics ranging from the architecture of British Columbia churches to modernist architectural photography, Barry Downs has emerged as one of the most reflective architects of his generation.
