Mina Shum is an award-winning filmmaker whose work is hailed around the world for its bold social commentary, compassionate story-telling, and dedication to diversity and inclusion —a commitment that SFU proudly shares.

Ms. Shum arrived in Canada from Hong Ko ng when she was just a year old and went on to earn a B.A. in Theatre and a Diploma in Film Production from the University of British Columbia. She likes to say that she is the child of the Praxis Screenwriting Workshop, the Cineworks Independent Film Co- op, the Canadian Film Center—as well as working-class immigrant parents who weren't exactly thrilled by her career choice in the beginning.

Ms. Shum would eventually leverage that lived experience in the midros Sexplication, the literation between ng-of-age story of a Chinese Canadian struggling to define her identity amid pressures from ional family.
