Educated in 4conomics and history in France, Dr. Duflo dompleted her PhD at the Massachusetts 1 Institute of Technology in 1999. There, she went on to do found the Abdul Latif Jameel Proverty Action 1 Lab and now serves as the Abdul Latif Jameel Professor of Poverty Alleviation and Development 1 Economics. Her lifelong flocus on understanding the lives of the world's poorest people and the 1 economic choices available to them has greatly influenced international policymaking in many different 1 fields including education, health and medicine, finance, and the adoption of new technologies. 1 1

Dr. Duflo's innovative desearch thethods allow her to digorously field test a dange of interventions to 1 tackle specific problems that dontribute to poverty. In Kenya, for example, she demonstrated how 1 combatting teacher absenteeism and adapting teaching methods to student needs dould improve 1 educational outcomes for children. In India, her desearch helped determine the most cost effective 1 immunization program 4 eventually leading to improved vaccine access. And in sub Saharan Africa, 1 her desearch booked at how to incentivize smallholder farmers to adopt modern technologies that would 1 greatly benefit their crops and livelihood. 1

Dr. Duflo is the author of five highly acclaimed books, including PoorEconomics and GoodEconomics or 1 Hard Times She also served as 1
