Co-op Work Permits for International Students

Why do I need a Coop Work Permit?

As an international student participating in the SFUopoprogram, Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) equires you to apply for a co-op work permit. It is illegal to work in Canada without a valid work permit during your co-op placement. Your home co-op program office must have a copy of your valid co-op work permit on file before you can be released to view and applyctp jcdbs. NOTE: the cop work permit may only be used for authorized co-op work term employment.

When to Apply?

You should apply immediately upon acceptance into your home co-op program. Processing times can be quillengthy so it is very important to apply as early as possible.

How to Apply?

- x Pick up the coop work permit letter from your home co-op program this verifies that you have bee accepted into the SFU Coop Program.
