Did you have an opportunity to apply course concepts to real-world situations? 1 = Never 2 = Sometimes 3 = Often	Applying concepts to real-world situations make them easier to understand, more relevant to students, and helps students to see how their classroom learning is applicable in other contexts.
Did working in groups or teams help your learning? 1 = Not at all 2 = A little 3 = Somewhat 4 = Mostly 5 = A lot	Group work is beneficial to students in learning how to work with others and in completing projects that are more complex than an individual could accomplish alone.
