The Faculty Council is the principal governing body of the Faculty of Education. The Executive Committee sets the agenda and the Dean or Dean's designate chairs the meeting. Voting members of the Faculty Council with the right to participate in decisions made by consensus or vote include:

continuing tenure-track (Instructors, Assistant Professors, Associate Professors, Professors) and continuing teaching faculty (Lecturers, Senior Lecturers, Laboratory Instructors);

limited term faculty with appointments greater than one year and of at least 50%;

one Coordinator representative and one Faculty Associate representative from both Field Programs and Professional Programs (as selected by the Coordinators and Faculty Associates from those program areas)

one undergraduate student (normally the Chair of the Education Student Association or designate); and

one graduate student (normally the Chair of the Education Graduate Student Association or designate).
