

COMPUTING STUDIES CERTIFICATE:

CGPA (Cumulative GPA), UDGPA (Upper Division GPA), and a CMPT/MACM GPA of 2.00 or better in order to complete the Certificate Program. Only courses taken at SFU are used in this calculation.

- Computing science course entry requires a grade of C- or better in each prerequisite course.
- A minimum 2.40 cumulative grade point average (CGPA) is required to access 200, 300 and 400 division computing courses.
- FAS Residency Requirements apply to this program:
 - At least half of the program's total units must be earned through Simon Fraser University study.
 - At least two thirds of the program's total upper division units must be earned through Simon Fraser University study.
