The Child Health Practice and Research Awards

Adjudication

These awards are adjudicated by the FHS Graduate Awards Committee.

The Committee issues a call for applications and selects the awardees using the following criteria:

- (a) relevance of practicum, project or other proposed activity to **health**;
- (b) prospects for supporting applicant's future academic or public health career plans related to **health**;
- (c) relevant academic, professional and **volunteer** achievements; and
- (d) likelihood of building capacity or benefitting **health**.

The number and value of awards granted will depend on the income available through the Dr. Djavad Mowafaghian Endowment Fund each year.
