



Program Requirements

For the Bachelor of Arts (BA) Health Sciences program, students complete 120 units, which includes:

- at least 45 upper division units
- at least 60 units that must be completed at Simon Fraser University
- satisfaction of the writing, quantitative and breadth (WQB) requirements
- an overall cumulative grade point average (CGPA), upper division CGPA, and program (HSCI) GPA of 2.0
- a minimum grade of C on all WQB, lower division and upper division course requirements.
