

How to use the washroom search

The latest update to [SFU Snap](#) and [Room Finder](#) allows users to see the locations of washrooms across SFU's three campuses, as well as filter results to search specifically for accessible and inclusive washrooms.

If you're accessing the washroom search from SFU Snap, you can turn your location services on to search for nearby washrooms. The ability to filter search results by washroom type is available via both SFU Snap and the Room Finder (link available on [Campus Maps](#) page at <https://www.sfu.ca/maps>).

Searching for a washroom

In order to activate the washroom search in SFU Snap or Room Finder, you can search for any of the following terms:

- Washroom
- Restroom
- Bathroom
- Toilet

You can also add additional terms to further refine your search. For example, you could search "washroom single accessible" to bring up a list that only includes single accessible washrooms, or "washroom inclusive multi" to bring up a list that only includes inclusive, multi-stall washrooms.

Search terms

Search terms can be mixed and matched, and added in any order. Only one filter from each category below (gender, occupancy, accessibility) can be activated at a time.

Available search terms include:

Gender

- "Women" or "Men" to specify gendered washrooms
- "Inclusive" or "Universal" to specify all-gender washrooms

Occupancy

- "Single" or "Multi" to specify a single-stall or multi-stall washroom

Accessibility

- "Accessible" to specify accessible washrooms

Additional Notes

- When searching, please note that attributes of washrooms in the search results may not contain the exact language used in the search.
- Please also note that signs on washrooms may not reflect language used in the search terms or results; signage is an ongoing project across our campuses.
- We are constantly working to improve the listings and search results for washrooms, alongside updating washroom signage and targeting accessibility improvements in washroom upgrades.
