 - Scholarship payment from supervisor's research grant

 - Scholarships and awards disbursed by Graduate Studies (e.g., PhD Research Scholarship, base allocation student support (BASE)d awards such as Graduate Fellowships (GF) and Travel and Research Awards, and donor awards)
 - External scholarships or awards (e.g., Argency awards, Mitacs).
 - Program % awards, including donor awards
- 7. Every effort will be made to providet adent funding in approximately equal increments over the course of the academic year.
- 8. Thefundingyearbegins in the fall term, and ends in the ummerterm for all students enrolled in the program. Students who begin the program in a semester other than the semester in which the funding year begins will have their funding according hyperbolic for the remaining potion of the academic year.
