

The Katherine Willett Award in Gerontology

Terms of Reference

The Katherine Willett Award in Gerontology was established at Simon Fraser University in 2018 with generous gifts from friends and colleagues in memory of Katherine Willett. The award is intended to provide recognition to undergraduate students in the Department of Gerontology who are involved in community service supporting seniors. At least one award, valued at a minimum of \$1,000 will be granted annually in any term to a full-time undergraduate student in good academic standing who is currently pursuing a diploma in the Department of Gerontology and has demonstrated community service with seniors.

Resume outlining applicant's involvement with seniors in the community

Letter of reference from someone that can verify the applicant's accomplishments in the community
