Note that the \$5,400 PhD Research Scholarship is awarded on top of all scholarships to a maximum of \$10,000. For example, a student with a \$35,000 Council award will also receive the PhD Research Scholarship. Note that students with funding more than \$33,000 may also apply for the PhD Research Scholarship. The funding is guaranteed as a part of the funding commitment.
