Enclosed is the <u>Registration Status</u> report for Summer 2019 (term 1194). This report provides a broader analysis of new and continuing students registered than the undergraduate enrolment report.

<u>Table 5</u> shows the distribution of new and continuing students by location of courses taken. 59% of students are taking courses at the Burnaby campus only (or Burnaby in combination with distance education), 9% are taking courses at both Burnaby and Surrey, 7% are taking distance education courses only, 6% are taking courses at the Surrey campus only (or Surrey in combination with distance education) and 5% are taking courses at both Burnaby and Vancouver.
