



The Department of Mathematics is offering a section of MACM 201 DISCRETE MATHEMATICS II which is designed for students who are interested in lectures that present ideas that go beyond the textbook basics. This special experience is designed for students who plan to take further math classes (MATH 240, MATH 340, MATH 341, MATH 342, MATH 343, MATH 345 especially). Mathematics program majors and minors are especially encouraged to participate.

The section (D200) will have classes at the same time as sections D100/D300 MWF 12:30 - 1:20 pm, but will meet in an alternate location. All sections (D100 - D400) will cover the same course topics and will have the same midterms and final exam. The Prime D200 section will also have slightly different weekly homework assignments.
