APPLICATION PROCEDURES

To apply for admission, students should access the <u>on-line application</u> system, indicating the year for which they seek entry. We only accept applications for Fall (September).

Application Fees for programs starting Fall 2024 or later - \$110 for applicants with Canadian transcripts, \$150 for applicants with international transcripts.

Must be paid by credit card (Master Card or Visa).

After you have paid the application fee, upload the following supporting documents through the online application system:

- 1. A current copy of your Curriculum Vitae.
- 2. The names and contact information of a minimum of three professional <u>referees</u> willing to complete a formal letter of reference. At least two of the referees should be from academic institutions. E- mail requests will be sent by the system inviting referees to submit the letters of reference electronically. Ask them to submit the reference letters on professional or institutional letterhead with signatures (tell them to **do not** type them even if the system gives the option)
- 3. Electronic copies of your transcript(s).
- 4. English Language Test (International Admission Requirements)
- 5. Statement of Interest

Our MESMS program doesn't not require you to have a supervisor.
