## FASS Requirements:

The PostBaccalaureate Diploma offers those who hold a bachelor's degree the opportunity to develop and follow a program of individualized study, not usually provided by graduate or professional degrees. The program responds to changing educational needs, wbareenid-advancement or changing career goals demand new knowledge and skills. The PBD may be completed on a full or patime basis. Students in a Postaccalaureate Diploma Program complete a total of 30 or more units of work (approximately one year of inde study).

## PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENT:

x Completion of a recognized Bachelor's degree with a minimum graduation grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 from a British Columbia university or a minimum GPA of 2.4 from a university outside of British Columbia.

## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- x Successful completion of an approved program comprised of 30 upper division units (courses at the 300 or 400 level), and some graduate courses if appropriate.
