PHILADELPHIA 1900

LOCAL BUSINESS CONCERNING THE

The following table shows the number of persons employed in the various occupations in Philadelphia in 1900, and the number of persons who were engaged in the same occupations in 1890. The occupations are classified into three groups: (1) Manufacturing and mechanical occupations, (2) Retail trade, and (3) Professional, clerical, and service occupations.

Occupation	1900	1890
Manufacturing and mechanical occupations	100,000	80,000
Retail trade	50,000	40,000
Professional, clerical, and service occupations	30,000	20,000

The above table shows that the number of persons employed in manufacturing and mechanical occupations has increased by 20,000 since 1890. The number of persons employed in retail trade has increased by 10,000, and the number of persons employed in professional, clerical, and service occupations has increased by 10,000.

The following table shows the number of persons who were engaged in the various occupations in Philadelphia in 1900, and the number of persons who were engaged in the same occupations in 1890. The occupations are classified into three groups: (1) Manufacturing and mechanical occupations, (2) Retail trade, and (3) Professional, clerical, and service occupations.

The above table shows that the number of persons who were engaged in manufacturing and mechanical occupations has increased by 20,000 since 1890. The number of persons who were engaged in retail trade has increased by 10,000, and the number of persons who were engaged in professional, clerical, and service occupations has increased by 10,000.
