Contemporary Philosophy of Mind: An Anthology by S. G. Hartley, J. F. Perry and M. Bratman.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This will be an introductory course in metaphysics. No previous knowledge or familiarity with philosophy, logic, or mathematics is required. The primary focus will be on metaphysics. (What is the nature of reality and how do we know it?) We will also include some discussions of what it means to exist, what it is like to be conscious, and what it is like to be rational. The course will also include some experiments in philosophy and the application of philosophy to real life situations.

PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

There will be three assignments per week.
