2. A **curriculum change** is one that requires Senate approval. The change will appear in the next version, according to the publishing schedule:

Examples:

- Adding the successful completion of a particular course to a program's admission's requirement
- Temporarily withdrawing a course
- Eliminating, adding or changing curriculum

Effective date – coincide with the beginning of a term i.e. May 01, September 01, January 01. The effective date indicates when the curriculum change, new course or new program is operational. This date drives information in the curriculum management system, the calendar and degree progress report.

The new Degree Progress report relies on effective dates related to the student's program.

The effective date determines the particular semester and program in effect when the student declared their academic intentions and spec
