The Chair noted that this item was mistakenly sent to Senate without SCUP approval. The item has now been submitted to SCUP in order to correct this oversight.

A committee member noted that a number of courses have been removed from the program and asked about the reason for this change. J. Derksen, Dean of Graduate Studies, commented that the previous iteration of this program was highly directive for students and that these changes, along with the name change, are intended to bring more flexibility for students.

A committee member asked if there are options for students who do not want to study big data. J. Derksen noted that these changes have been highly requested by students and the Ministry. There are other programs available at SFU for those students wanting to study a different subject area.

A committee member noted that pages 3-6 of the document should be removed from what is submitted to Senate since SCUP is only approving the name change. The Chair affirmed this change.

Hearing no further questions, the Chair asked for the motion to be called.
