Some of the suggestions and concerns were:

- x emphasize the international experience SFU- Griffith University partnership
- x mention other international partners if intention is to bring in other institutions ; just mentioning one partner might limit your audience
- x broaden the target audience for new student recruitment
- x work on the demand when preparing your FPP, including cost for international travel
- x consider supports to subsidize and enable broader participation/not elitist
- x identify total of units required up front; be consistent throughout document
- x a concern was raised regarding requirement "3 -4 elective courses from one of FCAT's approved international partners" should specifically mention Griffi th, add others in future
- x the certificate appears to be close to a minor
