02-1	Academic dishonesty. Plagiarism in three essays in the same course (UBSD 02-3). Grounds of Appeal: Section 8.1c, Policy T10.03 – excessive penalty.	SCODA denied the appeal and upheld the three semester suspension imposed by the President.
02-2	Academic dishonesty. Plagiarism. Tutor co-authored paper with student. (UBSD 02-57)	SCODA denied the appeal and upheld the one semester suspension imposed by the President.
