- iv) Amendments to non-minimal risk projects, which are designated by the DORE as minimal risk amendments, may be approved by the DORE for implementation and are subject to ratification by the REB at its next regular meeting.
- v) Protocols involving participation of persons who are aged 14 years or younger must contain approvals from the parents or legal guardians of the participants. Exception to this requirement may be made by the REB on a case-by-case basis.
- vi) When protocols require participants to comment on matters related to the agency or company that employ the participants, the consent protocol must include whether the company or agency has a) given permission,
