



**Procedure:**

Each appeal is first screened to determine whether special circumstances are present. All appeals are first heard in-camera (written form only); if the SAB is unable to give a positive judgment at this stage, and if the student has

further evidence and answer questions. Most hearings last about 20 – 30 minutes.
