4. Chair's Report (Dugan O'Neil)

There is a lot of discussion on return to campus plans and protocols and getting everyone back safely in September.

5. Dean of Libraries Report (Gwen Bird)

Library operations under COVID protocols have continued. The Library has engaged Diamond Schmitt Architects to develop a concept plan for phase 1 of WAC Bennett Library renewal. This will involve building a new 39,000 sq.ft. wing to the north of the existing Bennett Library. We are working with University Advancement on a capital campaign to raise \$20 million of the approximately \$42 million required to build the new wing.

Work is almost complete on the new Research Commons at Harbour Centre. The space is located on the 7th floor and is designed to meet the needs of the 1000 graduate students based at SFU Vancouver.

The Library has also engaged Commons Consulting to design and deliver a comprehensive antiracism education program for library staff this year.

6. COVID operations and planning under COVID (Gwen Bird)

A report was provided showing sample usage data of the services provided during COVID. Ljiljana asked how usage has differed from face to face interaction. Gwen advised items loaned has gone down, virtual reference consultations has gone up, instruction has decreased but workshop attendance has gone up substantially. two weeks before the start of classes.
