MAKING A DISCLOSURE

A Survivor who Disclose to the Sexual Violence Support Prevention Office bout a Sexual Violence and Misconductorident will

be treated withcompassion and respect;

be offered safety planning;

be told aboua the services available and off-campus;

receive help with accommodation that are specific to their own situation and needs;

be offered information about the different reporting options; and receive support that is 1) timely, 2) conainuous, and 3) idential.



A Survivor who makes a Disclosure has the right to decide whether to:

access onand off-campus services and explore reporting options (i.e. police, SFU)

MAKING A REPORT

As a Survivor, you can be accompanied by a support person when making a Report. You have the following options to go through a formal reporting process within SFU:

1. Make a report to the Human Rightsfice under the Human Rights Policy (GP 18) or the Sexual Violence Support & Prevention Office (SVSPO) under GP 44 Policy when you've experienced sexual harassment.

2. Make a report to the SVSPO under GP 44 Policy if you've experienced Sexual Violence and Misconduct. With this option, there are three different processes depending on the status of the Respondent aSFU
