

The Role of Perceived Partner Sexual Satisfaction in Individual Sexual Satisfaction

Relationship satisfaction and sex frequency are robustly related to sexual satisfaction (e.g., Impett et al., 2014), and recent work suggests that they are bidirectionally related to sexual satisfaction in couples (McNulty et al., 2014). However, the role of perceptions of partner's sexual satisfaction in individuals' own sexual satisfaction has received little empirical attention. Perceptions of partner sexual satisfaction may be important in committed relationships
