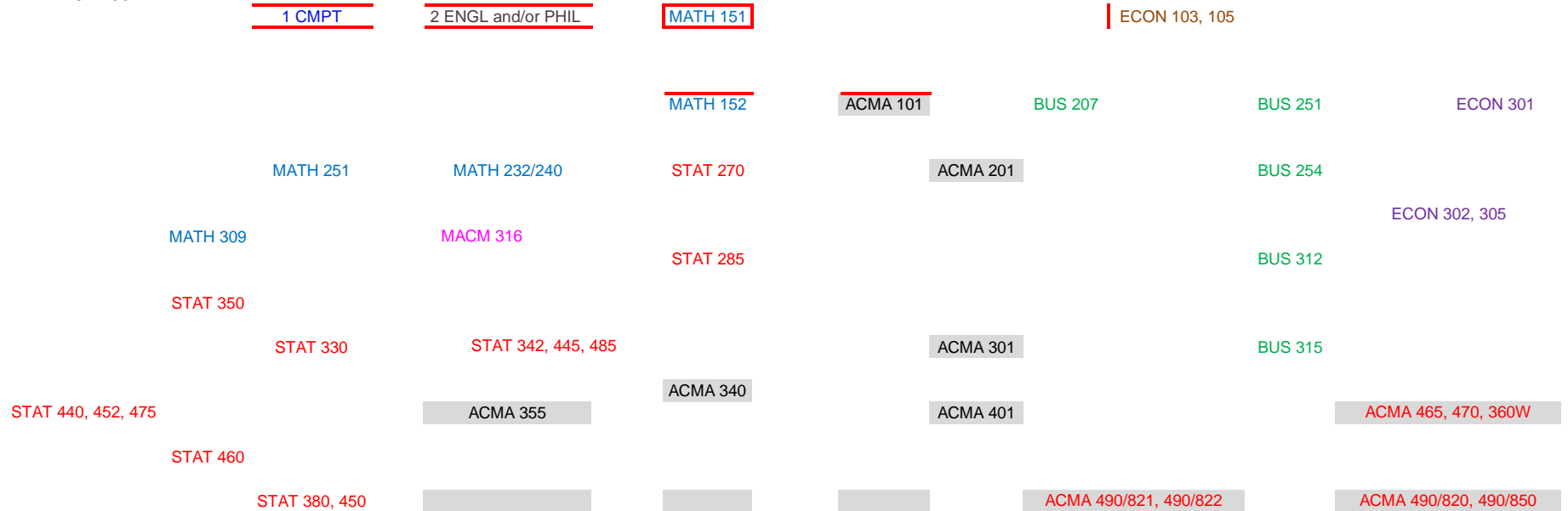


## Map of Courses Actuarial Program

**Major** (120 units) requiring completion of a minimum of 44 upper division units including a minimum of 28 units in the major subject or field.

one CMPT (recommend CMPT 110, 125, 126, 129, 130); two ENGL or PHIL courses

- List 3: three of ACMA 360W; BUS 312, 315; ECON 301, 302, 305; MACM 316; MATH 309; STAT 342, 350, 380, 440, 445, 452, 460, 475, 485
