4. An alternative for statistical software:

Although MINITAB still offers the best support for this course, Macintosh users will have difficulty finding the Mac version, MINITAB 10X. Alternative software for both Mac and PC is XLStats. This program assumes that you have Microsoft Excel on your computer (often installed as a part of Microsoft Office or sometimes as a separate program) and is based on Excel. Stats is an addition to Excel that simplifies the use of Excel for statistics.

XLStats can be downloaded from http://www.man.deakin.edu.au/rodneyc/XLstats.htm. The cost is approximately CDN\$25.
