

SELF REPORTING GRADES: FAQs

I CANNOT FIND A COURSE I'M TRYING TO SELF REPORT FROM THE DROP DOWN LIST ON MY STUDENT CENTRE. WHY?

Please ensure you are using the correct course number. For example, if you are trying to self report a grade for a Social Studies 11 course, you should enter the course number as follows:

11 Social Studies 11 (Canadian History) (11S110)

I AM TAKING A COURSE FROM THE APPROVED COURSE LIST ONLINE. SHOULD I SELF REPORT THIS COURSE?

Yes. All approved courses are eligible for self-reporting (see the approved course list for more information).

I DON'T HAVE A SOCIAL STUDIES 11 COURSE. CAN I USE A SOCIAL STUDIES 12 COURSE TO FULFIL THIS ADMISSION REQUIREMENT?

CAN I SELF REPORT MY GRADES MORE THAN ONCE?

No, you can only self report your grades once. If you have a grade for a course that is not an approved course for this admission requirement, you can self report your grade for that course. For more information, see the approved course list.
