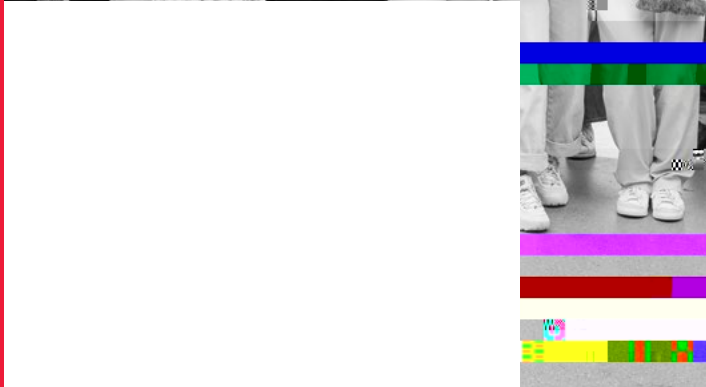


UGGLA FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

Ten scholarships are awarded per year to students who face significant financial barriers to participation in post-secondary education.

This may include students who identify as Indigenous, Black, or a person of colour, students living with disabilities, LGBTQIA2S+ students, and students of all gender identities.

The intent of the Uggla Family Scholarship is to promote equity and remove historical and existing discrimination, including barriers to full participation in social, cultural, economic, and political life.

The scholarship is only available to domestic (Canadian) students admitted for the fall term to any undergraduate degree.
