Q4. I am doing distance or communit pased learning that isoffered through a Provincial Tuition Waiver Program eligible school, and I am not located nearthe school. How can I complete a Provincial Tuition Waiver Program application form with the institution staff?

x Students can access the <u>Provincial Tuition Waiver Program application form</u> online, complete sections 1 and 3 and sign the document before sending it via email to the institution staff.

- x Many institutions have various additional supports available to eligible students. Please contact your Financial Aid Office or equivalent for more information.
- x If you are under the age of 27 you may also be eligible for Ministry of Children and Family Strengthening Abilities and Journeys of Empowerment (SAJE) Program, contact your local MCFD office to learn more.
- x You may also be eligible for a student loan. Visit <u>StudentAid BC</u> to learn more.

## Q10. What happens if I must withdrafform my program or coursefter my tuition and feeshave been paid for?

x If you must withdraw after your course/program drop date, you are not required to repay through this process.

### Q11. Can I claim aprovincial tuition waiver retroactively?

x Students may daim reimbursement for tuition and eligible fees paid at any time during the same fiscal year (April 1 March 31).

#### Q12. What if I am a parttime student?

x Part-time students are also eligible for the Provincial Tuition Waiver Program.

# Q13. I have already completed one credential through the Provincial luition Waiver Program, can I return and receive a provincial tuition waiver for another credential? What about noncredit courses?

x The Provincial Tuition Waiver Program can be applied to multiple courses, programs and credentials, below the graduate level, including non-credit courses. The Provincial Tuition Waiver Program is not available for Masters/graduate level studies.

## Q14. Is successful completion determinant of whether provincial tuition waiver is granted?

x No. If you meet eligibility criteria and have been issued a tuition waiver, your tuition and eligible fees will be waived for the duration of your studies, regardless of age.

### Q15. If I transfeschools, will my eligibility for the Provincial Tuition Waiver Program continue at my newschool?

x Yes. If you transfer to another eligible school (see full list here), your eligibility for the Provincial Tuition Waiver Program will transfer with you, and you will not need to reapply.
