Transcripts should include your last two terms <i>Transcripts may be requested online through goSFU</i>	* If you have attended a different institution in the last two terms, you should include transcripts from that institution as well.
Canadian Work or Study Permit	Provide copies of your immigration document(s) e.g. study permit, work permit, etc.	* Make sure copies are clear and legible
Proof of Means of Financial Support	Refer to the IRCC website to review minimum funds required for living expenses (under 'On or after January 1, 2024'): https://www.canada.ca/en/immigration-refugees-citizenship/services/study-canada/study-permit/get-documents.html#doc3	* Graduate students may request a letter from their department should they wish to include proof of financial support (i.e. TAsip or RAsip). * Refer to your online checklist for examples of acceptable proof.
Passport or Travel document	Scanned copies of all relevant passport pages	* Include all pages with photos, signatures, entry stamps and any other markings.
Digital Photo		* Photo specifications are in your online checklist.
Proof of Next Terms Enrolment	Official current SFU confirmation of enrollment (COE) letter <i>Generate the COE from your goSFU account</i>	* If you have already enrolled in courses for next term, use your COE for next term. * If not, use your COE for the current term.
Biometrics (<i>fingerprints and photo</i>)	If you gave biometrics in the last 10 years for a Canadian visa, work or study permit, and they are still valid, you do not have to give them again. Bring this letter and your valid passport when you give your biometrics at a designated Service Canada location. IRCC can only begin to process your application after you pay for and give your biometrics.
Non-refundable Processing Fee	The current fee for a TRV is \$100. If you are required to provide biometrics you will be charged an additional fee of \$85 when you submit your application.	* You can pay online using a credit card (IRCC accepts Visa, MasterCard, American Express, JCB, China Union Pay) or a debit card (IRCC accepts Visa Debit, Debit MasterCard or Interac).
