

Eligible international students can work on and off campus without a work permit. There are different requirements for working on campus and off campus. International undergraduate and graduate students who would like to work on and/or off campus must meet certain eligibility criteria as outlined below.

**On campus work**

Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) as employment facilities within the boundaries of the campus. Your employer can be SFU (e.g. temporary assignments), a faculty member, the Student Society, yourself (e.g. private tutoring) or a private business or private contractor providing services to the institution on the campus. This does **not** include Co-op placements or SFU-approved internships or practicums.

SFU students who meet the eligibility criteria to work on campus are permitted to work at any of the three SFU campuses
