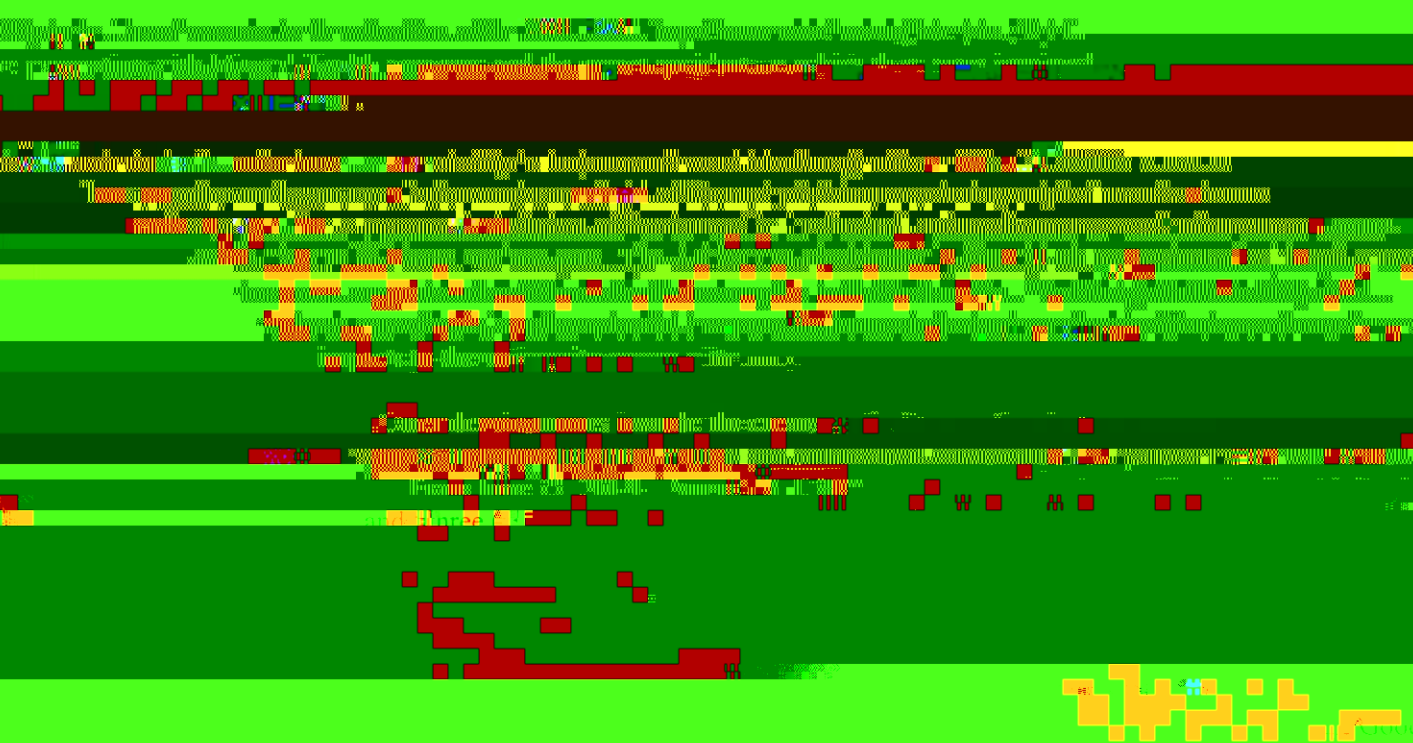

Senate Committee on Disciplinary Appeals

Reporting Period
September 2013 – August 2014

The **Senate Committee on Disciplinary Appeals (SCODA)** heard **three** appeals during the period covered by this report, all involving undergraduate students charged with academic dishonesty and plagiarism.

SCODA Appeal No. 2013-02 (academic dishonesty)

Appeal based on of University Policy S10.04, 2.1(iii), that the penalty was “excessive in all the circumstances of the case.” At issue was the assigning of an “FD” grade. . The

argued that the student had hired a private tutor to do an assignment for her. The student then sent the assignment to one other student. In the end, several students ended up submitting the same version of the assignment. In the second case, the student was caught taking a photograph with her phone of an in class quiz.
