

Exchange Application: Proposed Study Plan (Full-Time Exchange Program)

Research courses to determine that this host institution offers sufficient course options for you. This is a *proposed* plan of study and you are able to enroll in different courses at the host institution, as needed.

Step 1: On the host institution's website, check if the courses are open to exchange students as some hosts may have some restricted subjects or classes, these are often posted on their website.

Step 2: Is the course normally offered in the term that you plan to go on exchange? On the host institution's website you can review lists from previous years if they have not yet posted classes for your exchange term.

Step 3: Do you anticipate meeting the pre-requisite requirements posted for the course?

Step 4: Complete the chart below: Propose a minimum of 6 classes* you hope to take on your exchange.

- If information on the course code is not available, you can write N/A
- If exchange credit for the course you hope to take has previously been evaluated (look for your Destination's Exchange Credit History), indicate "Yes" under SFU Credit Previously Awarded and note the listed SFU course equivalent. See website for more information on how courses transfer back to SFU.
