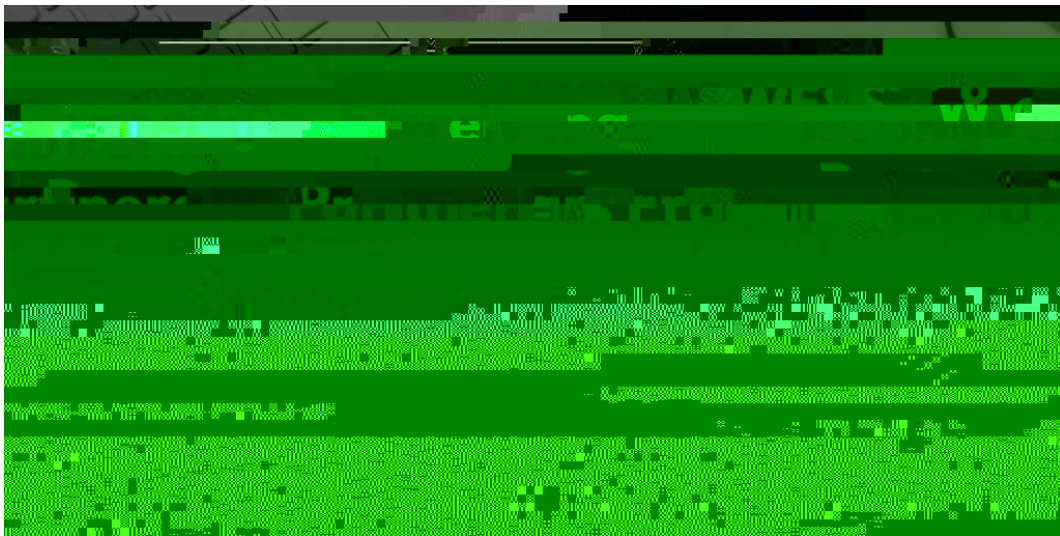

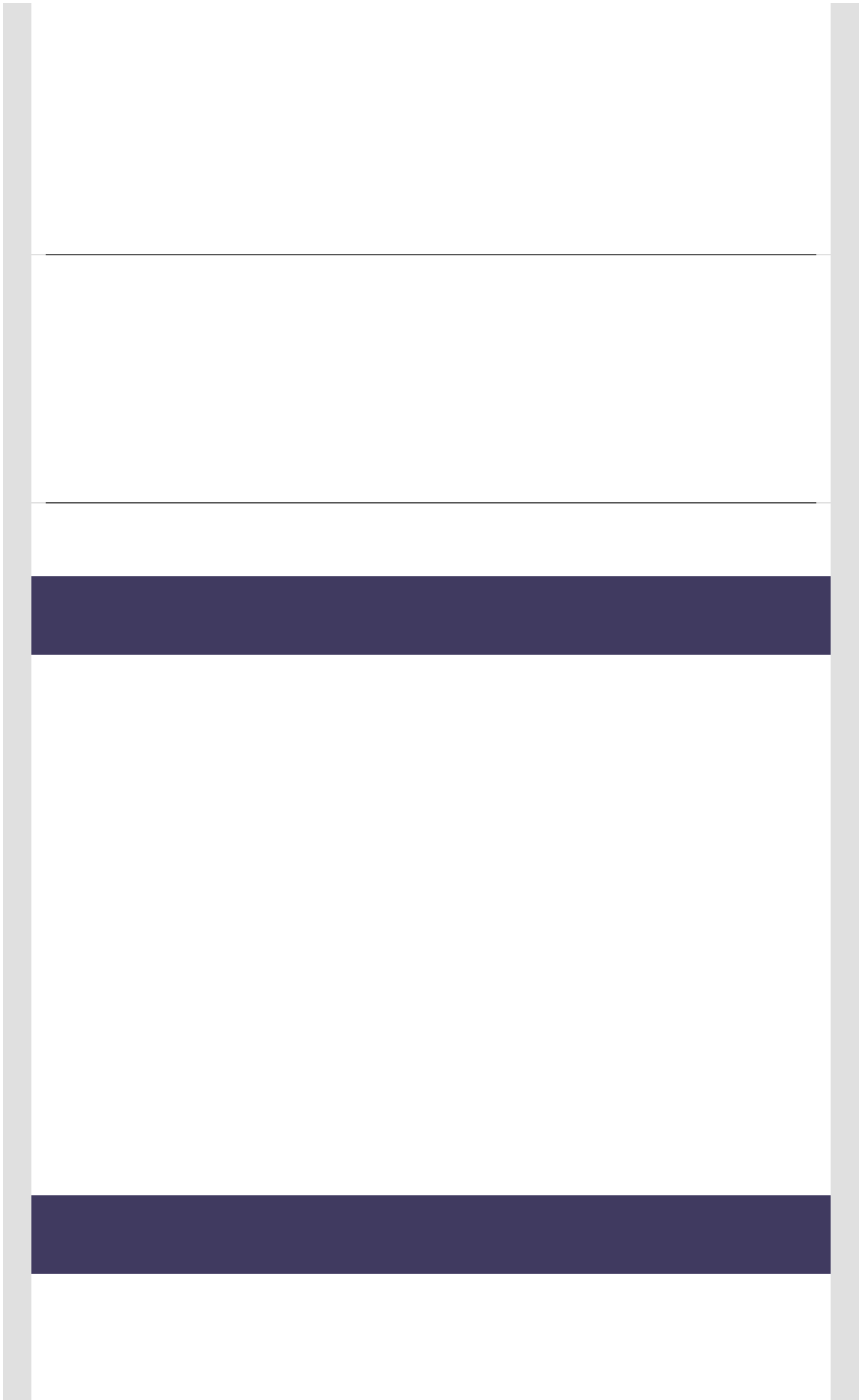
We are still accepting applications for our 2017-2018 Funding Partners program, organized with [eng•cite](#), until September 22.

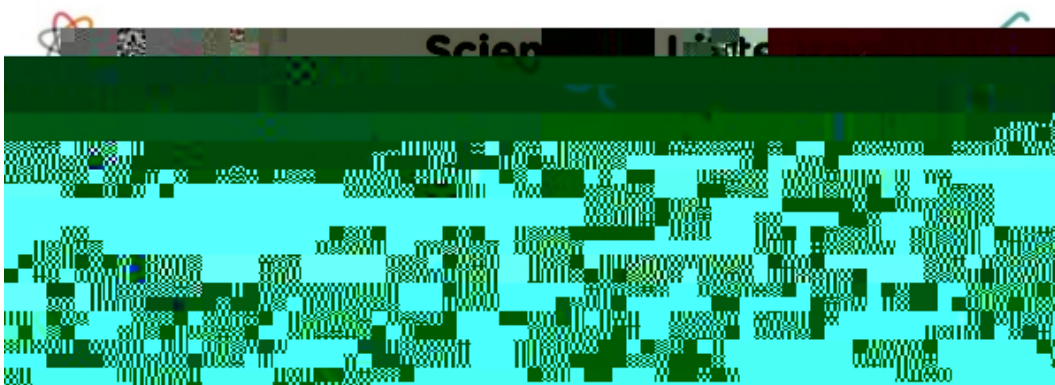

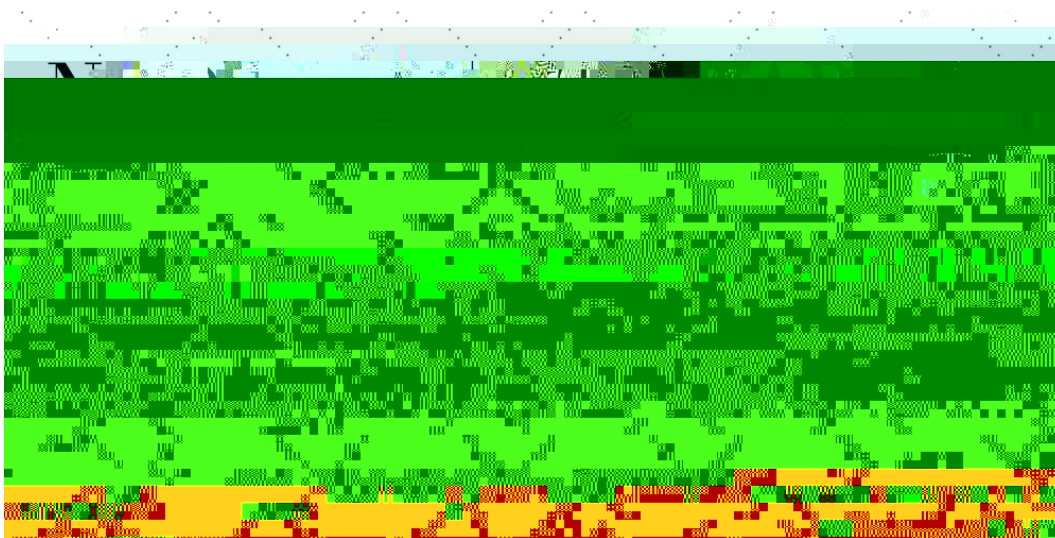

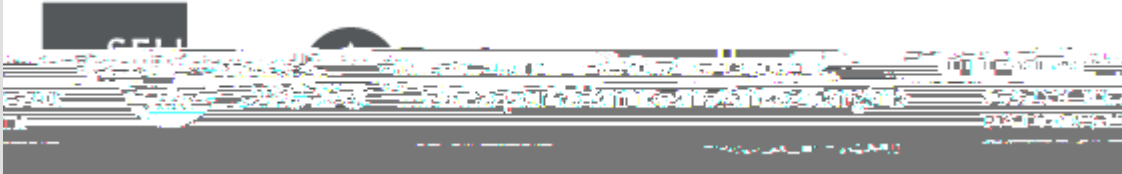
