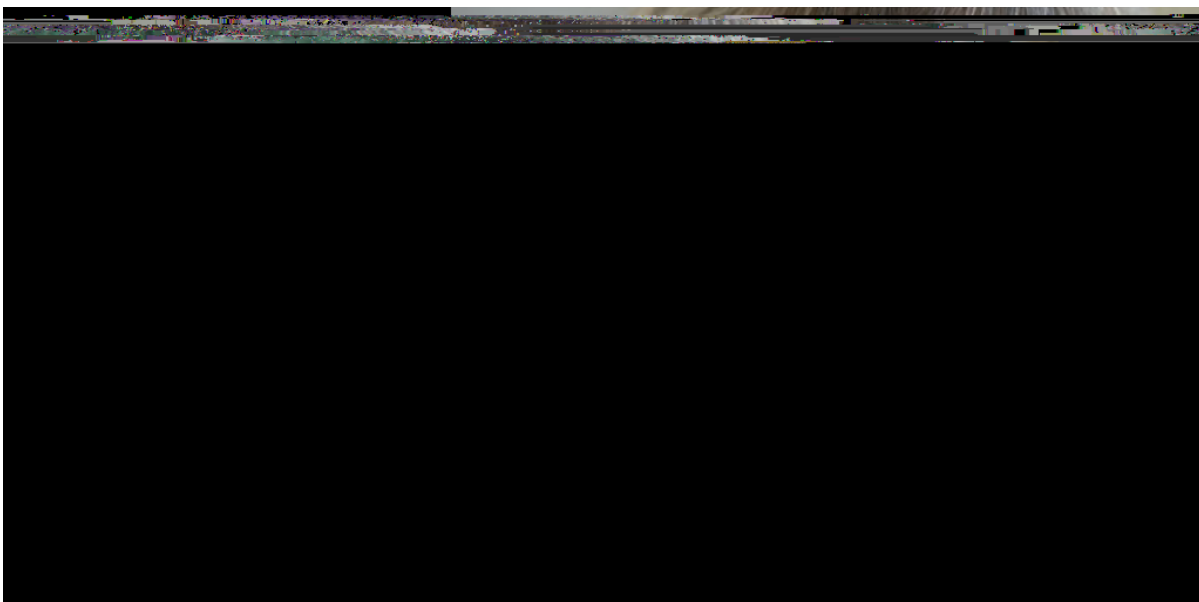

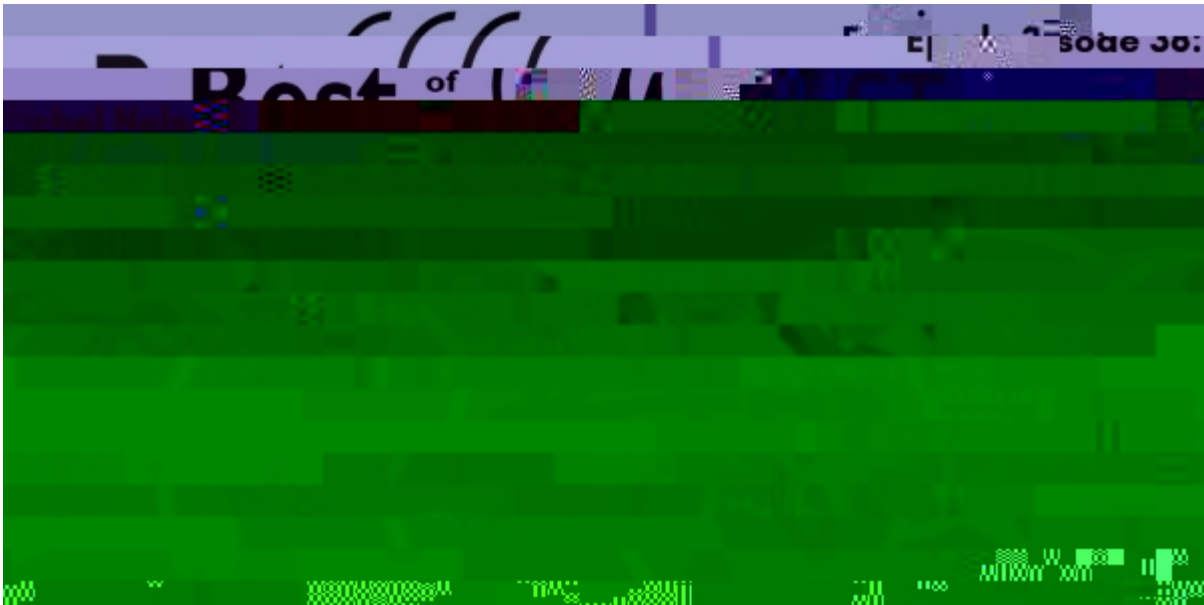
October 18: EGBC Annual Conference
