This position is contingent upon the applicant being successfully awarded a Tier 2 Canada Research Chair. The position is subject to the availability of funding and to final approval by the University Board of Governors and the CRC Secretariat.

Application Process

Candidates are asked to submit:

A cover letter outlining research, teaching, and service achievements, including indication of citizenship and/or residency status (2-3 pages);

A full curriculum vitae;

The proposed program of research, including an outline of the proposed CRC research program over five years, an explanation of how the proposed research aligns with and advances SFU's 2016-2022 <u>Strategic Research Plan</u>, and a discussion of how this Chair would strengthen graduate training at SFU (2-6 pages);

Teaching philosophy with a focus on graduate training (1-2 pages);

Short statement with a description of past or potential contributions to equity, diversity,
